Emergency System Installation

An Emergency Entry System has been installed at the South Gate permitting Emergency Services direct access to our community through either gate. This enables a quick response to homeowner needs.



Community Initiatives

1. Wise Property Management has provided 2 quotes on a Reserve Study. This would provide the Board with the ability to foresee where our current Reserve Needs stand from a funding perspective and whether funding is at the proper level. This should give us an eye to the future and eliminate surprises such as the Boardwalk Shortfall.
2. We received a quote and requested another from Wise for repair and painting of the 2 Gate Columns which are deteriorating.
3. Inspection of our wooden street signs has uncovered wood rot and deterioration. We've requested quotes for the replacement of the same architecture as the mailboxes and front signage.
