The Board narrowed Property Management Company finalists to 3 and interviewed each firm via video meetings. At this month's Board Meeting, the three were presented to the community members attending. A spreadsheet was shared with response to key issues about each for comparison. A question-and-answer session ensued. The Board will take the input received from the community and meet November 20th to decide which firm will be selected. The winner will be notified by November 27th, as will those that weren't selected.

Maintenance

The irrigation well was fixed and is now operational.

The 2024 Budget was approved unanimously at the November Board Meeting. It includes a \$10/month increase in Homeowner dues effective January 2024. \$5 will be matched and used to buy down the Boardwalk Loan while the other \$5 for Property Management fee increase and inflation.

The Mailbox committee evaluated options for new community mailboxes and provided a recommendation to the Board. The Board will review and discuss and come back with a plan.

The Property Manager reported that there were 3 nominations received during the open nomination period for the 3 open Board positions. Given this, state law says all 3 will be accepted and voting will be used to determine the term length of each. The top two vote getters receive a 2-year term, the other a 1-year term. Those nominations are all existing Board members:

Jeff Shorts, Frank Sierra, and Tom Daly.
